

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENT AND ELGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPATION

In order to participate in the Scholarship program, you must submit the below listed items to academic-scholarship@bwharrisalumniusa.org no later than April 30th.

- Submit a Statement of Good Moral Conduct - Must have evidence of good conduct indicated in your letters of recommendation and report cards. Submit Two (2) letters of recommendation. One must be from B. W. Harris Episcopal High School Administration and a person from your community.
- Submit Copy of Current Academic Report Card - Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of B or above.
- Participate in the tutorial program. You must be available to tutor other students in lower grades.
- Submit a one-page essay. Essay should include your background; career goals and how you plan to achieve them.
- Submit One (1) recent passport size photo.
- Must submit grades after each Marking.
- Must not have accumulated more than 10 absences during the current school year.
- Submit a completed and signed application by April 30th.
- Must have volunteered your time to B. W. Harris Episcopal High School activities.
- Must give back to B. W. Harris School during your scholarship enrollment term.
- An award is issued for an academic school year and may be renewed each academic year.
- Students of employees of the B W Harris Episcopal School are not eligible to participate.
- Students may not be a subject of any criminal offense.

When you apply to participate in the Scholarship program you agree to:

- A Personal Interview with your Parent/Guardian – You and your Parent/Guardian must be available to be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee.
